



Stonehenge Hostel

Stonehenge Hostel is a 70-bed bunk accommodation in Wiltshire, just minutes from Stonehenge and the Cathedral city of Salisbury.

Set in over 40 acres of Wiltshire Countryside on a rare breeds farm. It is far more than just a place to stay. Guests get free entry to the farm, play areas and grounds and with its onsite cafe, they can cater for groups with breakfast, lunch and dinners including takeaway options. The hostel gives a real countryside feel, and it's just off the A303 with plenty of free car and coach parking.

There are a selection on spaces available to hire on site, including their large events barn, you can hold seminars, meetings, events or even educational workshops. Make the most of the farm setting and book animal experiences like alpaca walking, scavenger hunts or private tours.

There are 14 individual rooms / 70 beds.

- One accessible room with wet room.
- 6 ensuite rooms
- 4 shared bathrooms.

Prices start from £30pp per night per bed. Sole occupancy booking of whole hostel starts from £1800 per night.
